COST: You must pay \$25.00 (non-refundable) when pre-registering and the balance on the first day of camp (or you may pay the entire amount when you pre-registering). Make checks payable to Alabama North SS Ministries. **All registration forms must be postmarked by May 18, 2009. A late fee of \$20.00 will be added to any registrations that are not postmarked by this deadline.** Late registrations will be taken on a first-come first-serve basis.

Arrival: Primary Camp will begin at 9:00 AM on Monday

Departure: Primary Camp will end at 3:00 PM on Wednesday

Everyone should be picked up no later than 3:30 PM so that Junior campers can move in.

Arrival: Junior Camp registration will begin at 3:00 PM on Wednesday

Departure: Junior Camp will end at 2:00 PM Saturday

Things to know – Children’s Camp 2009

Things to bring: Camp clothes, camp shoes, pool shoes and shower shoes, sleeping bag or sheets and blankets, pillow, towels (at least three), swimsuit, sunscreen, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, soap, washcloths, toiletries, Bible, pencil, flashlight, disposable camera, crazy hat.

Things not to bring: Electronic items, fireworks, knives, weapons, expensive items and bad attitudes. Do not bring snack money. This is covered in the cost of the camp. It is strongly suggested that parents keep cell phones at home. Phones are available if needed.

Mail: We will have mail call each day. Please send mail to your child at Camp Rolling Hills, 521 Hwy 304, Calera, AL 35040. Please send mail in advance to insure arrival during camp. (Just for fun, we will ask the children if they want us to read the letter out loud.) This is always a fun time.

Mountain Climbing: We will have a 26’ blow-up the kids can climb. It has a harness and is supervised. If you prefer your child not participate, please sign on the application form so we will know.

T-Shirts: This year the t-shirts are included for the children. (We are asking a \$6 donation by all workers to help cover the cost of their shirts.) Please mark your child’s size on your application.

Multiple Child Discount: If you have 2 or more children attending either of our children’s camps, you may deduct \$10.00 from the registration of the **second and each additional child.**

Emergency Number: You may reach the camp at 205-668-1168.

Late Fees: There will be a late fee of \$20.00 charged on all registration postmarked after Monday, May 18. This helps us insure adequate supervision and food is available.

Where to Mail Camp Applications: Mail to Denise Myers at 933 1st Avenue, Pleasant Grove, AL 35127. **These applications must be received by May 18, 2009.**

Where to Mail Counselor Applications: Mail to Denise Myers at 933 1st Avenue, Pleasant Grove, AL 35127. **These applications must be received by May 1, 2009.**

Children of Counselors: We will not be able to permit 5 year old (or younger) children of counselors to Primary Camp. Please do not sign up as a counselor if this will be a hindrance to you. However, we will permit 3rd grade children of counselors at Junior Camp if they are mature enough to participate as campers. They will be required to pay the registration fee.

Teen Counselors: We welcome teen helpers to camp if they are 15 years of age or older, and they must work in children’s ministry for at least a year. They must submit an application by May 1, 2009. However, we are requesting that they pay the camp fee. For Primary Camp

this is \$45.00 and for Junior Camp this is \$45.00. (t-shirts are \$6 this year). It is suggested the local churches help with the cost of their teen helpers.

We realize that no outdoor activity is without the possibility of unforeseen hazards, which could result in injury to an individual. For this reason, the Alabama North District provides supervision and directions for safe conduct of our camp activities. Many times these directions are not followed or are disregarded by campers in our programs, resulting to injury to a camper. Therefore, we ask that you instruct your camper(s) regarding the importance of proper conduct, which will insure safety and an enjoyable time while at camp. By signing this form you, as a parent or legal guardian, agree to assume risks and hazards which are inherent in camping activities sponsored by the Alabama North District Church of the Nazarene, Rolling Hills Conference Center and/or its owners, agents, or employees for damage, loss, or injuries to the persons or property undersigned. The Alabama North District Church of the Nazarene carries accident insurance as secondary insurance to individual or family coverage.

I understand that I am signing for the minor listed on this form and that the signature is both a medical and liability release. If an incident should occur which causes a dispute between the Alabama North District Church of the Nazarene, Camp Staff, or Rolling Hills Conference Center and myself, I agree not to press legal charges in a court of law, but will submit to arbitration by a representative of an organization established for such purposes, agreed by both parties.

In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency during the camp dates shown on this form, I hereby give my permission to the physician or dentist selected by the Children's Camp Staff to hospitalize, to secure proper treatment and/or order injection, anesthesia, or surgery for my child as deemed necessary. I also authorize the nurse on duty at the Alabama North District Children's Camp to administer aid as required for illness or injury under a physician's orders.

Children's Camp Policy requires all campers be checked for any contagious illness or condition such as fever, nausea, lice, etc. This will be done at registration by the camp nurse and staff. No child will be allowed to register who is not well.
